# FREQUENTLY ASKED Questions

## Q: ARE THERE ANY TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS?

To complete the course you will need access to the internet via WiFi or any 3G or 4G network, and a PC/laptop, or any Android or iOS compatible mobile/tablet device.

## Q: HOW LONG WILL THE COURSE TAKE TO COMPLETE?

This is a 60-hour training course, which means that you'll need to be able to dedicate 60 hours of your time to complete the course. Generally speaking you should be able to complete this course within 2-4 weeks.
